## Bonita National Off-Road Vehicle Use Policy Effective September 23, 2024

This policy outlines the rules and regulations for the use of dirt bikes, all-terrain vehicles (ATVs), remotely operated vehicles (ROVs), and other vehicles designed for off-road use within the private and common areas of the gated community to ensure safety, protect property, and maintain compliance with local, state, and federal laws. Gated community common areas include parks, open spaces, lakes, and other shared community properties. Please reference the separate Golf Cart Use Policy for guidelines specific to golf cart use within the community.

This policy may be updated or amended at the discretion of the Master Homeowners' Association's Board in response to changing community needs, state regulations, or feedback from residents.

For the purpose of this registration and acknowledgement, off-road vehicles are defined in Florida State Statute (FSS) 317.003 as:

- "OHM" or "Off-Highway Motorcycle" means any motor vehicle used off the roads or highways of this state that has a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and is designed to travel with not more than two wheels in contact with the ground, but excludes a tractor or a moped.
- "OHV" or "Off-Highway Vehicle" means any ATV, two-rider ATV, ROV, or OHM that is used off the roads or highways of this state and that is not registered and licensed for highway use pursuant to Chapter 320.

Use of privately-owned OHMs/OHVs in the Bonita National community requires registration and a permit issued by the Master Homeowners' Association and renewed annually. Vehicle owners must comply with the rules and regulations set forth below at all times.

**Owner shall initial and acknowledge the following rules prior to issuance of a permit:**

|  | Any use of a privately-owned OHM/OHV outside of the Bonita National community is beyond the scope of these rules and is the exclusive responsibility of the owner to know and adhere to FL law regarding vehicle title and registration.                   |
|  | All privately owned OHM/OHV must be in good working condition and equipped with efficient brakes, handlebars, and safe tires.  |
|  | OHM/OHV may be operated from sunrise to sunset.  |
|  | All privately-owned OHM/OHV must stay on our roadways and cannot be driven on private yards, between buildings/houses or on unpaved areas. Privately owned OHM/OHV cannot be driven on the sidewalks nor the Bonita National Golf course and its pathways. |
|  | OHM/OHV must be stored in a garage. Overnight parking in yards or on the street is prohibited.   |
|  | OHM/OHV operators shall obey all traffic laws and posted traffic signs. No reckless driving or stunts; all tires must stay on the road at all times.   |
|  | OHM/OHV operators must yield to pedestrians.   |
|  | Operators must have a valid driver's license to operate a street-legal OHM/OHV on public or community grounds.   |

|  | Minors without licenses are prohibited from operating OHM/OHVs on community roads. OHM/OHV cannot be operated in the Bonita National Community by anyone under the age of 16 without direct adult supervision. Additionally, all riders under 16 must wear a helmet and eye protection while operating the vehicle, regardless of whether they are on public or private property (§316.2074(3), Florida Statutes).                        |
|  | I agree to comply with the Florida State Statutes regarding the operation, OHM/OHV registration, and titling.   |
|  | I assume full responsibility for the operation of my personal OHM/OHV and agree to accept full responsibility for any liability that may arise from ownership and operation by myself and others operating my vehicle.  |
|  | I understand that these rules will be enforced within the Bonita National Community and violations are subject to fines as determined by the Master Homeowner's association. Any violation by a guest will be treated as a violation by the resident. Repeat violations may lead to suspension of privileges and potential reporting to local law enforcement.  |
|  | I agree to hold Bonita National Homeowners' Association, any other associations, corporations, or partnerships involved in the operation of Bonita National Community, harmless for liability arising out of the operation of my OHM/OHV.   |
|  | I am registering an "Off-Highway Motorcycle" or "Off-Highway Vehicle" as defined in (FSS) 317.003. I understand that I must comply with FSS 317.0002 and the requirements outlined by FLHSMV to include, but not limited to: equipment requirements, insurance coverage, title requirements and fees.
